


LOCATIONMAP

DUBAI EXHIBITION CENTRE AT A GLANCE

Dubai Exhibition Centre is comprised of two complexes:

NORTH COMPLEX

The North Complex has the size and flexibility to host a vast range of events, from large-scale conferences to more intimate gatherings. The 14m high ceilings and 17,000 sqm of floor space provide a sense of space, while its two conference rooms can each host more than 1,800 people.

The auditorium is completely reconfigurable for 200 to 2,000 people. With its multipurpose halls and flexible sizing, the venue also offers opportunities for everything from performances to business meetings.

SOUTH COMPLEX

The larger South Complex boasts 28,000 sqm of exhibition space and the ability to host a variety of functions, from single large-scale events, to concerts, or multiday conferences. The complex's 10m high ceilings give a sense of spaciousness, while its adaptability – the space can be divided into nine halls – ensures organisers can host anywhere from 300 to 20,000 quests.
